- During 2016-17, there were 335804 numbers of female registered workers and 387943 numbers of male registered workers working under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee scheme.
- During 2016-17, 4464 numbers of widows were given pension benefits. In the same year, 51750 numbers of old age persons availed old age pension benefits, out of which 31067 numbers were female. Similarly, there were 1276 physically handicapped persons who availed pension benefits out of which 479 were female.
- As per Census 2011 report, Nagaland has 29631 numbers of disabled persons. Out of which 16148 are male disabled and 13483 are female disabled. Among the types of disability, Hearing Disability (30 percent) has the highest followed by seeing disability (14 percent). Under work status, 52 percent of total disabled were Workers. 44 percent of disabled are literate.
